

MEASUREMENTS

MATERIALS

1 kit Aquarela, including a total of 8 balls Katia Capri: 2 balls ivory col. 82145; 1 ball each of light yellow col. 82180, pastel orange col. 82181, raspberry red col. 82182, salmon pink col. 82183, squirrel grey col. 82178, luminous green col. 82179.

Crochet hook: size E4 (US) or 3,5 mm

Yarn needle

Scissors

Sewing pins and a mat to block (optional)

STITCHES

Crochet chain, Double crochet, Single crochet, intarsia, Jacquard crochet (tapestry crochet)

VIDEOS

GAUGE

Take time to check gauge

Using size E4 crochet hook, in *Double crochet*:
23 sts and 9 rows = 4x4"

INSTRUCTIONS

The shawl is worked in 2 parts.

Each part consists of:

- a written pattern with row-by-row instructions
- schematics of the motifs and video tutorials of the stitches that are used

1st PART

Note: Using ivory, Double crochet and crochet chain, this shawl is worked in a half-moon shape with multi-color sections.

Turn work at the end of each row.

The 3 "turning" *chain sts* at the beginning of each row count as a stitch.

Using ivory, work 5 rows.

Chain 6 sts and work as follows:

1st row: 2 *Double crochet* into the 4th beginning *chain st*, 3 *Double crochet* into the same st, 3 *Double crochet* into the last *chain st* = 9 sts

2nd row: 3 *chain sts* and 2 *Double crochet* into the same st, 1 *Double crochet*, 2 *Double crochet* into the same st, 1 *Double crochet*, 3 *Double crochet* into the same st, 1 *Double crochet*, 2 *Double crochet* into the same st, 1 *Double crochet*, 3 *Double crochet* into the last st = 17 sts

3rd row: 3 *chain sts* and 2 *Double crochet* into the same st, 1 *Double crochet* into each st until 1 st remains and 3 *Double crochet* into the last st = 21 sts

4th row: 3 *chain sts* and 2 *Double crochet* into the same st, * 1 *Double crochet* into each of the next 3 sts, 2 *Double crochet* into the same st * repeat from * to * 3 more times and finish with 1 *Double crochet* into each of the next 3 sts, 3 *Double crochet* into the last st = 29 sts

5th row: 3 *chain sts* and 2 *Double crochet* into the same st, * 1 *Double crochet* into each of the next 3 sts, 2 *Double crochet* into the same st * repeat from * to * 5 more times and finish with 1 *Double crochet* into each of the next 3 sts, 3 *Double crochet* into the last st = 39 sts

Note: cut yarn and **weave in** ends of the yarn you are not using.

From here on continue to work using *intarsia*.

6th row: Set up the following color pattern: 9 sts using ivory, 5 sts using light yellow, 16 sts using ivory, 7 sts using raspberry red and 12 sts using ivory, working as follows: 3 *chain sts* and 2 *Double crochet* into the same st, * 1 *Double crochet* into each of the next 5 sts, 2 *Double crochet* into the same st * repeat from * to * 5 more times and finish with ~~2 *Double crochet* into the same st~~, 1 *Double crochet*, 3 *Double crochet* into the last st = 49 sts

7th row: Set up the following color pattern: 27 sts using ivory, 8 sts using squirrel grey and 24 sts using ivory, working as follows: 3 *chain sts* and 2 *Double crochet* into the same st, * 1 *Double crochet* into each of the next 6 sts, 2 *Double crochet* into the same st * repeat from * to * 5 more times and finish with 1 *Double crochet* into each of the next 5 sts, 3 *Double crochet* into the last st = 59 sts

8th row: Set up the following color pattern: 8 sts using ivory, 3 sts using salmon pink, 32 sts using ivory, 5 sts using luminous green, 20 sts using ivory, 5 sts using pastel orange and 4 sts using ivory, working as follows: 3 *chain sts* and 2 *Double crochet* into the same st, * 1 *Double crochet* into each of the next 3 sts, 2 *Double crochet* into the same st * repeat from * to * 13 more times and finish with 1 *Double crochet*, 3 *Double crochet* into the last st = 77 sts

9th row: Set up the following color pattern: 19 sts using ivory, 8 sts using light yellow, 24 sts using ivory, 8 sts using raspberry red and 32 sts using ivory, working as follows: 3 *chain sts* and 2 *Double crochet* into the same st, * 1 *Double crochet* into each of the next 6 sts, 2 *Double crochet* into the same st * repeat from * to * 9 more times and finish with 1 *Double crochet* into each of the next 5 sts, 3 *Double crochet* into the last st = 91 sts

10th row: Set up the following color pattern: 5 sts using ivory, 4 sts using squirrel grey, 14 sts using ivory, 5 sts using luminous green and 67 sts using ivory, working as follows: 3 *chain sts* and 2 *Double crochet* into the same st, 1 *Double crochet* into each st until you reach the last st, 3 *Double crochet* into the last st = 95 sts

11th row: Using ivory work: 3 *chain sts* and 2 *Double crochet* into the same st, * 1 *Double crochet*, 2 *chain sts*, skip 2 sts * repeat from * to * until the end of the row, then work ~~1 Double crochet~~, 3 *Double crochet* into the last st = 99 sts

12th row: Using ivory work: 3 *chain sts* and 2 *Double crochet* into the same st, 1 *Double crochet* into each st until you reach the last st, 3 *Double crochet* into the last st = 103 sts

13th row: Set up the following color pattern: 30 sts using ivory, 7 sts using light yellow, 17 sts using ivory, 5 sts using luminous green, 11 sts using ivory, 11 sts using raspberry red, 17 sts using ivory, 5 sts using pastel orange and 14 sts using ivory, working as follows: 3 *chain sts* and 2 *Double crochet* into the same st, 1 *Double crochet*, 2 *Double crochet* into the same st, * 1 *Double crochet* into each of the next 9 sts, 2 *Double crochet* into the same st * repeat from * to * 8 more times and finish with 1 *Double crochet* into each of the next 9 sts, 3 *Double crochet* into the last st = 117 sts

14th row: Set up the following color pattern: 32 sts using ivory, 6 sts using luminous green, 24 sts using ivory, 6 sts using light yellow, 18 sts using ivory, 6 sts using raspberry red, 30 sts using ivory, 6 sts using squirrel grey and 15 sts using ivory, working as follows: 3 *chain sts* and 2 *Double crochet* into the same st, * 1 *Double crochet* into each of the next 4 sts, 2 *Double crochet* into the same st * repeat from * to * 21 more times and finish with 1 *Double crochet* into each of the next 5 sts, 3 *Double crochet* into the last st = 143 sts

15th row: Using ivory work: 3 *chain sts* and 2 *Double crochet* into the same st, * 1 *Double crochet*, 2 *chain sts*, skip 2 sts * repeat from * to * until the end of the row, 3 *Double crochet* into the last st = 147 sts

16th row: Using ivory work: 3 *chain sts* and 2 *Double crochet* into the same st, 1 *Double crochet* into each st until the end of the row, 3 *Double crochet* into the last st = 151 sts

17th row: Using ivory work: 3 *chain sts* and 2 *Double crochet* into the same st, 1 *Double crochet* into each st until the end of the row, 3 *Double crochet* into the last st = 155 sts

Cut yarn and weave in the ends of each color.

See **graph A** for the motifs.

18th row: Using light yellow: 3 *chain sts* and 2 *Double crochet* into the same st, * 1 motif (= 2 *chain sts*, skip 2 sts, 1 *Double crochet*, 2 *chain sts*, skip 2 sts, 1 *Double crochet*) * repeat from * to * until the end of the row, 2 *chain sts*, 3 *Double crochet* into the last st = 25 complete motifs.

19th row: Using light yellow: 3 *chain sts* and 2 *Double crochet* into the same st, 2 *chain sts*, 1 *Double crochet* into the next st, skip the *chain-2* space * 1 motif (= 1 *Double crochet*, skip the *chain-2* space, 3 *Double crochet*, 2 *chain sts*, 3 *Double crochet* into the next st, skip the *chain-2* space) * repeat from * to * and finish with 1 *Double crochet*, 2 *chain sts*, 3 *Double crochet* into the last st = 26 complete motifs.

20th row: Using light yellow: 3 *chain sts* and 2 *Double crochet* into the same st, 2 *chain sts*, skip 1 st, 1 *Double crochet* into the next st * 1 motif (= 3 *chain sts*, 1 *Single crochet* into the *chain-2* space, 3 *chain sts*, 1 *Double crochet* into the next st) * repeat from * to * and finish with 3 *chain sts*, 3 *Double crochet* into the

last st = 26 complete motifs.

21st row: Using light yellow: 3 *chain sts* and 2 *Double crochet* into the same st, 1 *Double crochet* into each st, **except** the *Single crochet* where you need to work 2 *Double crochet*, until the end of the row, 3 *Double crochet* into the last st = 249 sts

22nd row: Using light yellow: work same as the **18th row** = 41 complete motifs.

23rd: Using light yellow: 3 *chain sts* and 2 *Double crochet* into the same st, 1 *Double crochet* into each st until the end of the row, 3 *Double crochet* into the last st = 257 sts

24th row: This row is worked in *Jacquard crochet (tapestry)* using ivory and light yellow.

Set up the following color pattern: 15 sts using ivory, 6 sts using light yellow, 6 sts using ivory, 10 sts using light yellow, 4 sts using ivory, 15 sts using light yellow, 3 sts using ivory, 6 sts using light yellow, 6 sts using ivory, 8 sts using light yellow, 5 sts using ivory, 7 sts using light yellow, 10 sts using ivory, 7 sts using light yellow, 5 sts using ivory, 7 sts using light yellow, 9 sts using ivory, 7 sts using light yellow, 2 sts using ivory, 5 sts using light yellow, 9 sts using ivory, 10 sts using light yellow, 4 sts using ivory, 6 sts using light yellow, 8 sts using ivory, 7 sts using light yellow, 3 sts using ivory, 5 sts using light yellow, 6 sts using ivory, 7 sts using light yellow, 3 sts using ivory, 4 sts using light yellow, 4 sts using ivory, 9 sts using light yellow, 8 sts using ivory, 9 sts using light yellow, 2 sts using ivory, 4 sts using light yellow, 4 sts using ivory and 6 sts using light yellow, working as follows: 3 *chain sts* and 2 *Double crochet* into the same st, 1 *Double crochet* into each st until the end of the row, 3 *Double crochet* into the last st = 261 sts

25th row: Using ivory: 3 *chain sts* and 2 *Double crochet* into the same st, 1 *Double crochet* into each st until the end of the row, 3 *Double crochet* into the last st = 265 sts

26th row: This row is worked in *Jacquard crochet (tapestry)* using ivory and pastel orange.

Set up the following color pattern: 13 sts using pastel orange, 6 sts using ivory, 7 sts using pastel orange, 7 sts using ivory, 12 sts using pastel orange, 7 sts using ivory, 6 sts using pastel orange, 2 sts using ivory, 5 sts using pastel orange, 10 sts using ivory, 13 sts using pastel orange, 8 sts using ivory, 8 sts using pastel orange, 4 sts using ivory, 4 sts using pastel orange, 5 sts using ivory, 8 sts using pastel orange, 9 sts using ivory, 9 sts using pastel orange, 4 sts using ivory, 8 sts using pastel orange, 6 sts using ivory, 3 sts using pastel orange, 4 sts using ivory, 6 sts using pastel orange, 10 sts using ivory, 3 sts using pastel orange, 4 sts using ivory, 10 sts using pastel orange, 6 sts using ivory, 9 sts using pastel orange, 5 sts using ivory, 3 sts using pastel orange, 8 sts using ivory, 8 sts using pastel orange, 7 sts using ivory, 4 sts using pastel orange, 6 sts using ivory, 6 sts using pastel orange and 6 sts using ivory, working as follows: 3 *chain sts* and 2 *Double crochet* into the same st, 1 *Double crochet* into each st until the end of the row, 3 *Double crochet* into the last st = 269 sts

27th row: Using pastel orange: work same as the **18th row** = 44 complete motifs.

28th row: Using pastel orange: 3 *chain sts* and 2 *Double crochet* into the same st, 1 *Double crochet* into each st until the end of the row, 3 *Double crochet* into the last st = 277 sts


29th row: Using pastel orange: work same as the **18th row** = 46 complete motifs.

30th row: Using pastel orange: work same as the **19th row** = 46 complete motifs.

31st row: Using pastel orange: work same as the **20th row** = 46 complete motifs.
