Exclusive crochet pattern for the *Crochet-Along Katia* Facebook group

MEASUREMENT: 59" x 21 5/8" (150 x 55 cm), approximately, once blocked

MATERIALS

COTTON-CASHMERE: 2 balls pine green col. 79

1 ball each of broom yellow col. 78, ivory col. 81, cream col. 53

Crochet Hook: sizes D3 & G6 (U.S.)/(3 mm & 4 mm)

Pins and base for blocking (optional)

STITCHES

Double crochet, chain st, half double crochet, single crochet, magic ring See basic stitches at: www.katia.com/en/academy

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GAUGE

Note: the sample swatch serves as a reference and is worked in *double crochet* Using the size G6 hook in *double crochet*:

16 sts & 9 rows = 4x4''

INSTRUCTIONS

This shawl is semi-circular in shape. The pattern is divided into 4 parts. The last part includes how to make the border.

Each part includes:

- Different graphs with stitch explanation key.
- Videos showing how to work at the start, the stitch repetitions and the end of the row.

VIDEOS

NOTES

The graphs are read from right to left for the right side rows of the work and from left to right for the wrong side rows of the work.

Weave in and fasten off the loose threads at the end of the work.





1st PART

Using the size G6 hook and pine green, make a *magic ring*. Work following **graph A**, changing colour on the following rows. **Note: cut** the yarns when making each colour change.

Graph A

R1-6: Pine green

R7-11: Ivory

R12: Pine green



= 1 double crochet

= 1 half double crochet

= 1 single crochet

= 1 pop corn (work 4 double crochet in the same st, after finishing the 4th st remove the crochet hook from the loop, insert the hook in the first double crochet (from front to back) then insert the hook through the free loop after the fourth double crochet (from back to front), pass through the loop).
