MEASUREMENTS

approximately 31 1/2" x 63" (80 x 160 cm), after blocking

MATERIALS

1 Katia KAL Equinozio kit with 7 balls of Katia Super Merino: 4 balls of beige (col. 8) and 1 ball each of: dark brown (col. 31), ochre (col. 32) and coral (col. 39).

Circular knitting needles: size 10 (U.S.)/(6 mm) with a 47" (120 cm) long cable

Wool sewing needle

Scissors

Stitch markers

Cable needle

Pins and a blocking surface/base (optional)







STITCHES

Garter st, stockinette st, jacquard st, knit through back of loop

1 increase towards the left: use the LH needle to pick up, from front to back, the bar of varn in between the st just worked and the next st to be worked and knit through back of loop.

1 increase towards the right: use the LH needle to pick up, from back to front, the bar of yarn in between the st just worked and the next st to be worked and work in knit through front of loop. See basic stitches at:

GAUGE

Using the size 10 circular needles in stockinette st: 15 sts & 20 rows = 4x4''

INSTRUCTIONS

The shawl is made up of 8 different types of sts. The pattern is divided in 4 parts, each part with different sts. Therefore, each graph is only worked once. The last part includes how to work the tassels. Each part includes:

- Different graphs with explanatory stitch legends
- Explanatory videos showing the techniques used on each graph

VIDEOS



Discover how to work each technique in the Equinozio KAL on our YouTube canal.

Each video includes **labels with instructions** available in Spanish, English, French, Dutch, German and Italian. Activate the **Subtitles** option on YouTube to follow each step easily.





NOTES

Read the graphs from right to left for the right side rows of the work and from left to right for the wrong side rows of the work.

Fasten off the loose ends of varn at the end.

2nd PART

Using ochre:

R1: 3 garter sts, 1 increase towards the left, work in knit to stitch marker, 1 yo, k1 (= central st), 1 yo, work in knit to last 3 sts, 1 increase towards the right, 3 garter sts.

R2: 3 garter sts, work in knit to stitch marker, p1 (= central st), work in knit to last 3 sts, 3 garter sts.

Cut the ochre yarn.

Using dark brown:

R3: 3 garter sts, 1 increase towards the left, work in knit to stitch marker, 1 yo, k1 (= central st), 1 yo, work in knit to last 3 sts, 1 increase towards the right, 3 garter sts.

R4: 3 garter sts, work in knit to stitch marker, p1 (= central st), work in knit to last 3 sts, 3 aarter sts.

R5: 3 garter sts, 1 increase towards the left, * 1 yo, k2 tog *, repeat from * to * as far as the stitch marker, 1 yo, k1 (= central st), 1 yo, * k2 tog, 1 yo *, repeat from * to * until the last 3 sts, 1 increase towards the right, 3 garter sts.

R6: 3 garter sts, work in knit to stitch marker, p1 (= central st), work in knit to last 3 sts, 3 aarter sts.

Total: 115 sts.

Cut the dark brown yarn.

Continue the work following **GRAPH D**.

Total: 179 sts.






GRAPH D

Note: The grey square only represents the central st and the relief design.

R1-R26: Beige

R27: Beige-ochre (ochre for the bobble st)

R28-R32: Beige



- R2 Repeat 5 times in total
- 1 knit st
- 1 purl st
- 1 increase towards the right
- → 1 increase towards the left
- + 1 garter st
- This st does **not** exist, it is an empty space on the graph
- U 1 yo, on the following row work the yo in knit or purl through back of loop
- * 1 bobble st = using ochre, work 3 sts in the same st (k1, yo, k1), turn work and work these 3 sts in purl st, turn work and work these 3 sts in knit st, pass the 2nd st over the 3rd st and the 1st st over the 3rd st. There will be 1 st left. **Cut** the ochre yarn and continue with beige.
