# Hat

**Design:** Schachenmayr Design Team

Knit



Easy



Recommended Yarn

## SIZE

**Head circumference:** approx. 49 – 54 cm

## MATERIALS

**Schachenmayr Luxury Velvet Color**, 100 g ball

Approx. 100 g ≈ 75 m

Col. 00081 (rose color) 1 ball

The amount of yarn needed can vary from person to person.

Double Pointed Needles size 6.0 mm (US size 10)

1 faux fur pom-pom, approx. 15 cm ø (Aheadhunter)

1 tapestry needle for weaving in ends

## GAUGE

**Garner stitch:** 11 st and 20 Rd = 10 x 10 cm

## THE BASICS

### Ribbed pattern:

Alternate k1 and p1.

### Garner stitch in Rd:

Alternate 1 Rd knit, 1 Rd purl.

**i** If necessary, you can fix the the threads of the open ends of yarn by holding them carefully to an open flame to melt the fibers. This should only be done by an adult either outdoors or over a fireproof surface. Be aware of glowing and/or smoldering fibers that could fall down.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Loosely cast on 54 st and divide evenly between 3 double-pointed needles (= 18 st per needle); join to work in the round and place a marker at the beginning of the round.

Work in rounds in the ribbed pattern for 2.5 cm.

Then continue working in garter st in rounds.

When the piece measures a total of 19 cm from the cast on edge, after a purl Rd, begin decreases.

In the **next Rd**, work every 8th and 9th st as k2tog = 48 st.

**Rd 2:** without increases, work garter stitch.

**Rd 3:** (knit every 7th and 8th st together) 6x = 42 st.

**Rd 4:** without increases, work garter stitch.

**Rd 5:** 21x k2tog = 21 st.

**Rd 6:** 10x k2tog, k1 = 11 st.

Cut the yarn, draw the yarn through the remaining 11 st and weave in the yarn on the wrong side.

## FINISHING

Sew the pom-pom on the tip of the hat.

Weave in all ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit  
p = purl  
Rd = round(s)  
RS = right side  
st(s) = stitch(es)  
WS = wrong side
