



# Mittens

Intermediate





Recommended Yarn

#### SIZE

**Before felting:** wrist circumference mittens approx 27,5 cm, hand circumference approx. 22,5 cm, length approx. 36,5 cm.

**After felting:** wrist circumference mittens approx. 23 cm, hand circumference approx. 18 cm, length approx. 24,5 cm.

#### **MATERIALS**

Schachenmayr Wash+Filz-it! Fine Multicolor, 100 g ball

Approx. 100 g  $\approx$  200 m

Col. 00082 (Pacific color) 1 ball

The amount of yarn needed can vary from person to person.

Double Pointed Needles 5.0 mm (US size 8)

1 stitchholder

1 tapestry needle for weaving in ends

## **GAUGE**

#### Stockinette stitch:

Before felting: 16 st and 22 Rd = 10 x 10 cm After felting: 19 st and 33 Rd = 10 x 10 cm

#### THE BASICS

## Stockinette stitch in Rd:

Knit all st in every Rd.

**Increase 1 M zunehmen:** make 2 st in 1 st: knit front and back.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

Cast on 44 st and divide evenly over 4 double-pointed needles (= 11 st per needle); join to work in the round and place a marker at the beginning of the round. Work in stockinette st in rounds.

In the 9th Rd, work the last 2 st on each needle as k2tog (4x). Repeat these decreases once more in the 18th Rd = 36 st

When the piece measures 12 cm = 27 Rd from the cast-on edge, begin the **thumb gusset**: inc 1 st before the first st on Needle 1. Then in every other following Rd, inc 1 st on each side before and after the previously increased st 6x = 100 kg

13 gusset st.

Work another 2 Rd, then place the 13 gusset st on a holder. For the **bridge of the thumb**, cast on 2 new st above the held st: 1 st each on Needles 4 and 1. You should now have 10 st each on Needles 1 and 4 and 9 st each on Needles 2 and 3 = 38 st.

Continue working in stockinette st; in the 2nd Rd, work the 1st and 2nd st on Needle 1 and the last 2 st on Needle 4 each as k2tog = 36 st.

When the piece measures 31 cm = 69 Rd from the cast-on edge, shape **fingertips**: k2tog at the end of each needle in every other Rd 5x, then in every Rd 2x = 4 st fewer in each dec Rd = 8 st. Cut the yarn, thread it through the remaining 8 st and pull snugly. Weave in the end.

For the **thumb**, pick up 2 st from the bridge of the thumb in addition to the 13 held st = 15 st. Divide these st between 3 double-pointed needles = 5 st per needle.

Work in stockinette st in Rds.

When you have worked 7 cm = 16 Rd from the beginning of the thumb, begin decreases: k2tog at the end of each needle 3x = 3 st fewer per decrease Rd = 6 st.

Cut the yarn, thread it through the remaining 6 st and pull snugly. Weave in the end.

Work the 2nd mitten in the same way.

### **Finishing**

To felt the mittens, wash in the machine on the regular cycle at 40° C using color detergent (not wool detergent). Pull the wet mittens firmly into shape. You can use the handle of a wooden spoon to shape the thumb. Be sure to separate any sections that may have felted together (especially the thumbs) before drying. Allow the mittens to dry.
