Knit



Intermediate



Recommended Yarn

MATERIALS

Schachenmayr #netzporter, 250 g ball
Approx. 250 g = 375 m
Col. 00098 (anthrazit) 1 ball

1 circle needle 3.5 mm, 80 cm long
1 circle needle 6.0 mm, 60 cm
1 crochet hook 6.0 mm
1 tapestry needle for weaving in ends

GAUGE

Garter stitch wit size 6.0 mm needle:
19 st and 34 Rows = 10 cm x 10 cm

BASIC TECHNIQUES

Provisional cast-on:

Using the crochet hook and a contrasting-color yarn, crochet a loose chain, working about 10 st more than the number needed. Knot the yarn loosely at the end.

Working from the back of the crocheted chain, using the desired knitting yarn to pick up and knit the required number of st through the bumps in the middle of each chain stitch.

When you have finished the knitted piece, undo the loose knot at the end of the crocheted chain and unravel the chain one stitch at a time, picking up the open stitches in the knitted piece with a knitting needle.

Garter stitch: In rows: knit all st.

In the round:

Row 1: * knit all st

Row 2: * purl all st.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 for pattern.

Lace pattern:

multiple of 2 st + 1 + 2 selvage st.
Use the 6 mm (US size 10) needle.

Row 1: selvage st, k1, * yo, k2tog through the back loop, repeat from *, end with 1 selvage st.

Row 2: selvage st, k1, * yo, k2tog through the back loop (1 yarnover and 1 knit st from previous row), repeat from *, end with 1 selvage st.

Repeat these 2 rows for pattern.

Selvage edge:

Slip the 1st st of each R knitwise with the yarn behind your work.

Knit the last stitch of each R.

This produces 1 knotted edge st for every 2 rows.

Straps: Using the 3.5 mm (US size 4) needle, work in rounds in garter st.

INSTRUCTIONS

Using the crochet hook and the 6.0 mm (US size 10) knitting needle, work a provisional cast-on: knit 43 st from the crochet chain.

For **Rows 1 and 2**, k all st.

Beginning with **Row 3**, change to the lace pattern and continue working until the piece measures 30 cm.

Then change to garter st and work in rows for another 10 cm.

When the piece measures a total of 40 cm from the cast-on edge, change back to the lace pattern and work for another 30 cm.

When the piece measures a total of 70 cm, work another 2 R in garter st and then begin **decreasing** in the 3rd R as follows:

Row 3: 1 selvage st, k2tog, k to 3 st before the end of the row, k2tog, end with 1 selvage st.

Row 4: knit (no decreases)

Row 5: 1 selvage st, k2tog, k to 3 st before the end of the row, k2tog, end with 1 selvage st.

Row 6: knit (no decreases)

Row 7: 1 selvage st, k2tog, k to 3 st before the end of the row, k2tog, end with 1 selvage st.

Row 8: re M str. (ohne Abnahme)

Row 9: 1 selvage st, k2tog, k to 3 st before the end of the row, k2tog, end with 1 selvage st.

Row 10: knit (no decreases)

Row 11: 1 selvage st, k2tog, k to 3 st before the end of the row, k2tog, end with 1 selvage st.

Row 12: knit (no decreases)

Row 13: 1 selvage st, k2tog, k to 3 st before the end of the row, k2tog, end with 1 selvage st.

Row 14: knit (no decreases)



Row 15: 1 selvage st, k2tog, k to 3 st before the end of the row, k2tog, end with 1 selvage st.

In the WS row, bind off all st loosely.

At the short cast-on edge on the opposite side, first undo the provisional cast-on, picking up the 43 freed st with the 6.0 (US size 10) needle. First work 2 R in garter st across the picked-up st; then begin working the **decreases** as described above in **Rows 3-15**.

Bind off all stitches loosely.

The net bag only takes shape once the straps have been attached.

For the straps, use the 3.5 mm (US size 4) needle and cast on 50 st.

Then pick up 1 st from each knotted edge st on the side of the bag piece. To do so, begin at the diagonal formed by the decreases, continue along the straight section and then along the diagonal on the opposite side of the net.

For the second strap, cast on another 50 st and pick up 1 st from each knotted edge stitch on the other side of the net. Join the st to work in the round and work in garter st in Rds over all st as follows:

Round 1: k all st.

Round 2: p all st.

Repeat **Rounds 1 and 2** 5x more.

Bind off all stitches loosely.

FINISHING

Weave in all loose ends. Dampen the net bag and block lightly. Allow to dry thoroughly.

p	= purl
RS	= right side
st(s)	= stitch(es)
WS	= wrong side
